

School Safety Reporting

Per **HB2119-A.R.S. 15-153** Liberty High School is required to report to local law enforcement any *suspected* crime against a person or property that:

- A. is a “serious offense” - A.R.S. 13-706(F)(1), or involves a “deadly weapon” – A.R.S. 13-105(15), or “dangerous instrument” – A.R.S. 13-105(12), or “serious physical injury” – A.R.S. 13-105(39); and,
- B. any conduct that poses a threat of death or “serious physical injury” – A.R.S. 13-105(39) – to an employee, student or other person on school property.

Liberty High School will notify the parent or guardian of each student who is involved in a suspected crime or any conduct described above. Liberty requires its employees and volunteer staff to comply with reporting requirements. The school will maintain a record regarding any employee or volunteer who is disciplined under the policy, and, on request, make that record available to any public school that is considering hiring that person.
